



Co-Principal Cellist of the Brisbane Symphony Orchestra

Brisbane's leading community orchestra, Brisbane Symphony Orchestra, is seeking expressions of interest for the ongoing position of Co-Principal Cellist.

This position will involve:

1. leading the cello section for some programs (to be worked out by arrangement with the current principal cellist);
2. playing solo orchestral work as applicable/required; and
3. some administrative responsibilities, including but not limited to:
 - leading and organising cello sectional tutorials;
 - taking part in bowing meetings with other strings principals;
 - recruiting other section members as required; and
 - regularly communicating with and organising the other members of the cello section.

The ideal candidate will have extensive orchestral experience and a playing level of at least AMus/LMus standard.

This is not a remunerated position, however the successful candidate will have the ability to be involved in programming of concerts and other aspects of orchestral administration. You may also have the opportunity to play solo work with the orchestra, subject to programming and other considerations.

A shortlist of applicants will be created and April auditions are envisaged. All applicants will receive acknowledgment of their application and status.

The audition will involve:

- playing one solo work of your own choice; and
- three orchestral excerpts (as advised at least two weeks before the audition).
